The Future Skills Questionnaire (FSQ) is a short, accessible questionnaire that tracks the progress of learners' career-readiness at key transition points.



FSQ covers key aspects of knowledge, skills and attitudes that are important for successful transitions.

Simple data insights support you to target interventions, evaluate progress, and measure careers education impact.

PLAN THE DELIVERY: Engage those at risk of becoming NEET to identify barriers and areas for support.


ANALYSE THE RESULTS:
